授業テーマ Students' will develop basic writing skills in a variety of formats and topics through structured and self-chosen writing assignments.		
授業の概要と目標 The aims of this course are to develop Students' writing abilities on several levels: choosing topics and getting ideas, reviewing basic grammar and vocabulary necessary to write in a variety of formats, organizing ideas into paragraphs and longer compositions, and expressing their own opinions and narratives.		
評価方法 Students will be graded on class work and on several longer writing assignments. Depending on students' needs, grammar and other reviews and exercises will be given. For each lengthy assignment, 2 grades will be given: one for grammar, spelling, format, etc., and the other for creativity and ideas. Students will be required to finish a 1300-word , non-graded, journal.
