授業の概要と目標 Taking a process approach to writing, students will discover how to write paragraphs and complete essays

授業スケジュール・内容 Students will learn the main components of an essay. First they will learn about the components of a paragraph and how to successfully write one using a topic sentence, supporting sentences and a concluding sentence. Students will practice writing paragraphs using a process approach which will help them how to choose topics that are interesting and broad enough to write about. Students will also learn how to constructively peer evaluate written work. Then students will learn about how paragraphs can be joined together to form essays. Students will learn how to make a thesis statement. Students' first essay will be a four paragraph essay which looks at the advantages and disadvantages of a particular topic. Students will complete this course by submitting a written paper and by working together to produce a group magazine.
