| <p>授業スケジュール・内容</p> <p>In the first week students will participate in icebreaking activities so that students can get to know each other better and build a cohesive learning group. Students will also work together to formulate a list of class rules and guidelines for making a good learning environment.</p> <p>In the following weeks, learners will learn about journal writing in English. Students will be required to make an Internet blog and students will be required to read each other's blogs.</p> <p>Student will also be required to read five graded readers per semester and to write journals about the graded readers that they are reading.</p> <p>Students will be expected to improve their vocabulary and will be required to make vocabulary cards produce example sentences.</p> <p>Students will be required to submit drafts of written work to the teacher who will give feedback so that students can improve their work in later drafts.</p> | | |
