<p>授業テーマ</p> <p>Students' will develop basic writing skills in a variety of formats and topics through structured and self-chosen writing assignments.</p>		
<p>授業の概要と目標</p> <p>The aims of this course are to develop Students' writing abilities on several levels: choosing topics and getting ideas, reviewing basic grammar and vocabulary necessary to write in a variety of formats, organizing ideas into paragraphs and longer compositions, and expressing their own opinions and narratives.</p>		
<p>評価方法</p> <p>Students will be graded on class work and on several longer writing assignments. Depending on students' needs, grammar and other reviews and exercises will be given. For each lengthy assignment, 2 grades will be given: one for grammar, spelling, format, etc., and the other for creativity and ideas. Students will be required to finish a 1500-word , non-graded, journal.</p>
