接業スケジュール・内容 Students will learn writing full paragraphs about a variety of topics. Students will be set tasks to write about themes that they will investigate. This may involve interviewing people, getting facts from the Internet, or visiting a place (e.g. a park or a cafe etc.) In addition, students will learn strategies about how to come up with ideas, such as brainstorming and freewriting. Students will be introduced to a processing approach to writing where the teacher will comment on at least two drafts and where students get the opportunity to share work with others for peer review. Students will also be required to keep a blog to which the teacher and other students can respond. Students will have the opportunity to respond to other students work. To enhance both written and global English skills, students will be required to participate in extensive reading activities. Students will be required to read five graded readers from the school library. It is also necessary for students to make vocabulary cards and to review them everyday. Students will also be required to write example sentences using new vocabulary for elaboration and consolidation purposes. The teacher will test students vocabulary regularly. There may be the opportunity for students to make a simple website containing some of their written work.
