<p>授業テーマ</p> <p>More Practice and Fun Writing Essays and Making an Internet Magazine</p>		
<p>授業の概要と目標</p> <p>In this second semester course, students will practice planning, drafting, revising, and editing essays. Students will also be required to produce at least one article for an on-line class magazine.</p>		
<p>評価方法</p> <p>Students will be evaluated by quizzes, journal entries, homework, and class work and project work.</p>

<p>授業スケジュール・内容</p> <p>Students will practice writing a variety of essays. Each essay will be responded to by the teacher at least two times before the final draft.</p> <p>Students will continue to respond to each other's work. This will help the author to improve his or her writing skills. Also, by reading each others' work students can be exposed to a lot of different writing styles and ideas which will ultimately help their writing.</p> <p>An on-line magazine project will also be set during this semester. Time will be allocated for students to do some of this work in class. Students will work in groups of around six people in order to achieve this task. Students will be collectively responsible for the front cover, the theme, the magazine name, and the general layout of the magazine. Students will be individually responsible for their own written magazine articles.</p> <p>Students will also keep an on-line journal (blog) to communicate with people in the class regarding their work.</p> <p>Extensive reading is very good for building vocabulary and improving global English ability, so students will also be required to read five graded readers from the school library throughout the semester.</p>
