<p>授業テーマ</p> <p>Learning how to write good paragraphs and keeping journals</p>		
<p>授業の概要と目標</p> <p>Students will learn how to effectively write a paragraph through a process approach to writing. Students will also keep regular learning journals to write about what they have learned.</p>		
<p>評価方法</p> <p>Students will be evaluated by vocabulary quizzes, journals, homework, assignments class work, and small tests.</p>

<p>授業スケジュール・内容</p> <p>By the end of this course, students will be writing full paragraphs about a variety of topics. Learners will be set tasks to write about themes that they will investigate. This may involve interviewing people, getting facts from the Internet, or visiting a place (e.g. a park or a café etc.)</p> <p>Students will also be required to keep a blog to which the teacher and other students can respond. Students will have the opportunity to respond to other students work.</p> <p>In addition to writing, students will be required to participate in extensive reading activities. Students will be required to read ten graded readers from the school library (five in the first semester and five in the second).</p> <p>Students will be required to make vocabulary cards and to review them everyday. Students will also be required to write example sentences using new vocabulary for elaboration and consolidation purposes. The teacher will test students vocabulary regularly.</p> <p>There may be the opportunity for students to make a simple website containing some of their written work.</p>
